- 4. That the school shall have classroom of adequate space commensurate with the enrolment which is comfortable and suitable for imparting lesson and not less than the number of class units.
- That the school have a playground for the students and a barrier free access.
- 6. (a) That the school shall have separate toilet for the boys and girls in case of co-ed school)and teachers.
- 6. (b) That the school shall have girls common room, if it is a girls or co-ed school, teachers room and adequate furniture. '
- 7. That the school shall have sufficient fire safety equipments and have trained person/s among the staff to operate those equipments.

25. That the school authority shall ensure that there shall not be any activity in the school which may create acrimonious feelings or division among students on the basis of caste, creed, race or religion.
